DEVELOPMENT OF SPORTSGROUNDS IN LAMBRECHTSDRIFT

Tender Notice and Invitation to Tender

Dawid Kruijer Municipality invites tenders for the development of sportsgrounds in Lambrechtsdrift.

Tender documents are available from BVi Consulting Engineers, 55 Bult Street, P.O. Box 1155, Upington, at an amount of R500,00 in cash or electronic transfer per document, payable to BVi Consulting Engineers. This amount is non-refundable. Tender documents will be available from **Wednesday 17 June 2020 @ 11h00**.

Sealed tenders marked, "**CONTRACT TN013/ 2020 (33232.01): DEVELOPMENT OF SPORTSGROUNDS IN LAMBRECHTSDRIFT, NORTHERN CAPE**" must reach the Municipal Manager or be placed in the tender box before or on **Friday 10 July 2020 at 14:00** and will be opened directly thereafter in the Councillors' Caucus Room at the Municipal Offices.

A compulsory site inspection will be held at **10:00** promptly on **Friday, 19 June 2020** at the Lambrechtsdrif Community Hall. The doors will be locked at **10:00** promptly after which no further Tenderers will be allowed.

Only representatives of the tenderer will be allowed in the tender meeting who is:

1. In full time/ part-time employment of the bidder
2. Has the adequate experience to comprehend the scope of works.

The following conditions will apply including the standard Conditions of Tender or Tender Procedures contained in the Tender document:

1. Prices must be valid for ninety (90) days from tender closing date.
2. Prices quoted must be inclusive of VAT.
3. A firm delivery period must be indicated.
4. The tender document must be completed in black Ink by means of a ball point pen. Pencil entries will render the tender offer non-compliant. Computerized/ typed tenders will be disqualified.
5. The Tender document must be completed on the original tender document. Copies of the tender document or parts thereof will render the document non responsive.
6. The lowest bid will not necessarily be accepted. Bids per fax or E-mail will also not be considered.
7. Bidders are required to provide a realistic construction period, taking into account long leading items.
8. Penalties will be applied for late completion of the Works according to "**Section B, Specifications of the Tender Document**".
9. Bids will be evaluated in accordance with the applicable Preferential Point Scoring System as set out in the Councils Supply Chain Management Policy.
10. The following forms, **MBD 1, MBD 4, MBD 5, MBD 6.1, MBD 6.2, MBD 7.1, MBD 8 and MBD 9** must be completed and submitted with the bid.
11. Bids that are late or non-compliant will not be considered, whilst the lowest or only bid will not necessarily be accepted. Bids per fax or E-mail will also not be considered.
12. A minimum CIDB grading of **6CE or Higher** is required for this tender.
13. Letter from SARS including access PIN to validate TAX clearance and VAT registration should be submitted with the tender offer.
14. Bidder must be registered at the National Treasury's Central Supplier Data Base (CSD) and proof must be submitted.
15. **No B-BBEE** points would be allocated if:
 - 15.1 Certified copy of the B-BBEE verification certificate. Verification certificate will only be accepted if the verification agency is accredited by South African National Accreditation System (SANAS) or a certified copy of the B-BBEE certificate or
 - 15.2 An original Sworn Affidavit is not attached to this bid document.

16. Letter of good standing from the compensation commissioner is required.
17. The following compulsory documents must be submitted with the bid document and failure to submit the documents will render the bidder's bid non-responsive:
- 17.1 A copy of the Municipal account not older than 3 months.
 - 17.2 If the bidder is not liable for levies for municipal services, a Sworn Affidavit indicating reasons as to why a municipal account cannot be submitted and/or a Lease Agreement indicating such must be provided.
 - 17.3 The Bidder must submit at least two (2) projects successfully completed (attach summary sheet, contact list to be contacted, project value, project description and completion certificate) in the past ten (10) years for the development / upgrade of sportsgrounds, which should include at least three (3) of the following areas of consideration, such as pavilions, sports courts, sport fields, Hunter Irrigation, bulk water supply and reservoirs. Proof must be submitted. If no proof is submitted your tender will be deemed as non-responsive.
 - 17.4 Submit audited annual financial statements for the past three years, if your bid price exceeds R 10 million
18. The following bidders are eligible to submit tender offers for evaluation according to the Preferential Procurement Pre-Qualification requirements:
- 18.1 **Only Level 1 BBBEE contributor.**
19. A signed Joint Venture agreement must be submitted with the tender submission. Additional Joint Venture documents must be submitted as per Standard Conditions of Tender, Annex C.
