ELECTRIFICATION OF HOUSES IN LOUISVALE ROAD AND DAKOTA ROAD, UPINGTON

Bids are hereby invited for the supply and installation of electrical connections in Louisvale Road and Dakota Road, Upington. This tender comprises inter alia the following Works:
Underground 11 kV cable feeders, miniature substation (s), ring main unit, underground and overhead low voltage reticulation with underground and overhead service connections and consumer installations, split unit pre-paid metering and removal of overhead low voltage lines for high mast lights.

Tender documents and specifications are available from BVi Consulting Engineers, 55 Bult Street, P.O. Box 1155, Upington, at an amount of R500,00 in cash or electronic transfer per document, payable to BVi Consulting Engineers. This amount is non-refundable. Tender documents will be available from Monday 25 November 2019 @ 11h00.

Sealed tenders marked, "**CONTRACT TN066/ 2019 (33942): ELECTRIFICATION OF HOUSES IN LOUISVALE ROAD AND DAKOTA ROAD, UPINGTON**" must reach the Municipal Manager or be placed in the tender box before or on **Friday 10 January 2020** at 14:00 and will be opened directly thereafter in the Councillors' Caucus Room at the Municipal Offices.

A compulsory site inspection will be held at **11:00** promptly on **Friday, 29 November 2019** at the offices of BVi Consulting Engineers. The doors will be locked at **11:00** promptly after which no further Tenderers will be allowed. The Certificate that the Tenderer has visited the site will at the same time be signed by the Engineer. For further information, contact the Consulting Engineers, at telephone number (054) 337 6600.

Only representatives of the tenderer will be allowed in the tender meeting who is:

- a) In full time/ part-time employment of the bidder
- b) Has the adequate experience to comprehend the scope of works.

The following conditions will apply including the Conditions of Tender or Tender Procedures contained in the Tender document:

1. Prices must be valid for ninety (90) days from tender closing date.
2. Prices quoted must be inclusive of VAT.
3. A firm delivery period must be indicated.
4. The tender document must be completed in black Ink by means of a ball point pen. Pencil entries will render the tender offer non-compliant. Computerized/ typed tenders will be disqualified.
5. The Tender document must be completed on the original tender document. Copies of the tender document or parts thereof will render the document non responsive.
6. The lowest bid will not necessarily be accepted. Bids per fax or E-mail will also not be considered.
7. Bidders are required to provide a realistic construction period, taking into account long leading items.
8. Penalties will be applied for late completion of the Works according to the formula stated in the contract data.
9. Bids will be evaluated in accordance with the applicable Preferential Point Scoring System as set out in the Councils Supply Chain Management Policy. The following forms, MBD 1, MBD 4, MBD 5, MBD 6.1, MBD 6.2, MBD 7.1, MBD 8 and MBD 9 must be completed and submitted with the bid. Clause 2.1 for functionality will also form part of the tender evaluation.
10. Bids that are late or non-compliant will not be considered, whilst the lowest or only bid will not necessarily be accepted. Bids per fax or E-mail will also not be considered.
11. A minimum CIDB grading of 6EP is required for this tender.
12. Letter from SARS including access PIN to validate TAX clearance and VAT registration should be submitted with the tender offer.
13. Bidder must be registered at the National Treasury's Central Supplier Data Base (CSD) and proof must be submitted.
14. No B-BBEE points would be allocated if:
 - 14.1 Certified copy of the B-BBEE verification certificate. Verification certificate will only be accepted if the verification agency is accredited by South African National Accreditation System (SANAS) or a certified copy of the B-BBEE certificate or
 - 14.2 An original Sworn Affidavit is not attached to this bid document
15. Letter of good standing from the compensation commissioner is required.
16. The following compulsory documents must be submitted with the bid document and failure to submit the documents will render the bidder's bid non-responsive:
 - 16.1 Registration (Letter/ Registration Certificate) at the National Bargaining Council for the Electrical Industry of South Africa (N.B.C.E.I) must be submitted with the bid document.
 - 16.2 Registration with the Department of Labour as an Electrical Contractor in terms of the Occupational Health and Safety Act, 1993, Electrical installation Regulation No. 6(4).
 - 16.3 Certified copy of the intended Electrician's Wiremen's licence.
 - 16.4 Certified copy of Electrician's certification to work on Medium Voltage networks up to 11kV as per ORHVS Regulations.
 - 16.5 Certified of copy Construction Health and Safety Officer's (CHSO) valid registration with the SACPCMP.
 - 16.6 Certificates of completion and/or practical of completion certificates for electrification projects for both underground and overhead electrification accumulating to at least 1500 houses in the last 5 years.
17. The following bidders are eligible to submit tender offers for evaluation according to the Preferential Procurement Pre-Qualification requirements:
 - 17.1 Minimum Level 1-2 BBBEE contributor.
18. A signed Joint Venture agreement must be submitted with the tender submission. Additional Joint Venture documents must be submitted as per Tender data F2.1.

19. Minimum threshold for local content :

19.1 Electrical Conductors	90%
19.2 Steel Value-added Products	100%
19.3 Primary Steel Products	100%
19.4 Wooden Poles	100%
